Transfer credits for **Advanced Physical Assessment**, **Advanced Pathophysiology**, and **Advanced Pathophysiology** coursework must have been completed within the past than 5 years prior to matriculation into the program. An online diagnostic reasoning test for the 3Ps must be completed with a cumulative score of 80%.

- If coursework was taken greater than 5 years prior to matriculation into the program, student must enroll in all three courses for credit.
- If student is an actively practicing advanced practice nurse (NP, CNS, CRNA, Mid-Wife) or CNL and desires to change their specialty to the Family Nurse Practitioner they must submit syllabi from the master's or post-master's nurse practitioner program for evaluation of equivalency.
- If student is an actively practicing advanced practice nurse in (NP, CNS, CRNA, MW) or CNL, NRSC 604 Advanced Physical Assessment can be waived *after* demonstrating competency in the head-to-toe assessment exam using the TUC SON program rubric.

The student will complete a total of **630 direct clinical hours** as part of the Family Nurse Practitioner portion of the program (through clinical rotations).
